Parent Governor Nominations and Elections

We are inviting nominations for **TWO** Parent Governors.

You are invited to stand for election as a parent governor, or nominate another parent to do so. The term of office is four years from 14 October 2019.

We would particularly encourage parents with a background in Law, HR or Education to consider standing, but all parents, no matter what their field, are eligible and welcome to apply.

The governing body, with the headteacher, has overall responsibility for the running of the school. No special qualifications are needed and the most important thing is to have a keen interest in the school and be prepared to play an active part in the governing body's work. Training is available for all governors and this governing body has an expectation that those new to being a governor attend free induction training.






