Resilience Day – Wednesday 20th November

Resilience is an essential characteristic for students to be able to continually progress and to better enjoy their education, yet it is a challenging trait for students to develop. At Woodford County High School we want to help all of our students to become resilient young adults and to support them with this we are excited to announce that Wednesday 20th November will focus on developing resilience.

Each year group will be attending an hour presentation with Anthony Bennett who will share the troubles he faced as a student and how he overcome these as a means to help our students see that obstacles are not a dead-end, but instead a challenge to overcome. Students will have the opportunity to ask Anthony questions and we hope students later reflect on the presentation with Anthony to develop their own resilience.


