Parent Governor Elections

Following the close of nominations yesterday, EIGHT nominations were received and a secret ballot will be held to fill the TWO Parent Governor vacancies on the Governing Body of Woodford County High School.

The prize will be a tour and afternoon tea at the Houses of Parliament for the winners and their guests, conducted by a local MP. Competition entries can be submitted via this link:



September 25th


