Curriculum

- **1.** To ensure that a broad and balanced curriculum which fits with in with the aims and the philosophy of the school is provided.
- 2. To review any changes to the curriculum including associated changes to the staffing establishment and costs.
- **3.** To make such arrangements as are necessary to fulfil the governors' statutory obligation to monitor the National Curriculum in the school.
- 4. To consider reports from curriculum reviews and make recommendation to the Governing Board when appropriate.
- 5. To review arrangements for handling complaints concerning the curriculum.
- 6. To approve arrangements for daily collective worship.
- 7. To monitor the School Self-evaluation document.
- 8. To monitor Special Educational Needs provision (including provision for Gifted and Talented students)

Performance

- 9. To review the analysis of examination results and statistics.
- 10. To consider SEF Section 1 document including progress measures (ALPs, Level 3, FFT and RaiseOnLine)
- **11.** To agree targets with the school for the coming year.
