

WORKSHOPS COVERED ELEMENTS OF FINANCIAL EDUCATION RELEVANT TO STUDENTS' LIFE STAGE. 
STEM CAREERS AND EMPLOYABILITY

ALUMNI TALK

- ON 4TH DECEMBER 2019, ALL YEAR 11 STUDENTS HAD OPPORTUNITY TO ATTEND INTERACTIVE TALK ON STEM CAREERS. THE GUEST SPEAKER, ESTHER WERSHOF WAS WCHS ALUMNI. ESTHER LEFT WCHS IN 2010 AND STUDIED MATHS AT UNIVERSITY. SHE HAS JUST FINISHED HER PHD AND SHE IS ONE OF THE FRANCIS CRICK INSTITUTE'S CANCER RESEARCHERS. AS A MATHEMATICIAN SHE THOUGHT SHE WOULD END UP WORKING IN THE CITY, UNTIL SHE SAW AN ADVERT FOR A JOB IN ACADEMIA. NOW SHE WORKS WITH BIOLOGISTS, USING MATHEMATICAL MODELS TO GET A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF HOW CANCERS SPREAD. THE BODY SEES CANCER AS A WOUND, AND SENDS FIBROBLAST CELLS, WHICH LAY DOWN COLLAGEN FIBRES, TO "REPAIR" IT. THE FIBRES OFTEN LINE UP, SERVING AS "HIGHWAYS" FOR THE CANCER TO SPREAD TO OTHER PARTS OF THE BODY. ESTHER STUDIES THE PATTERNS OF THESE FIBRES, HOPING RESEARCHERS COULD ONE DAY DISRUPT THEM. THE SESSION WAS INSPIRING FOR OUR STUDENTS.



