Your First Day!

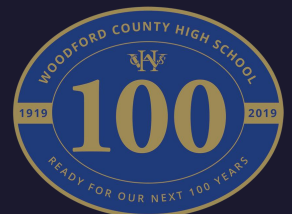
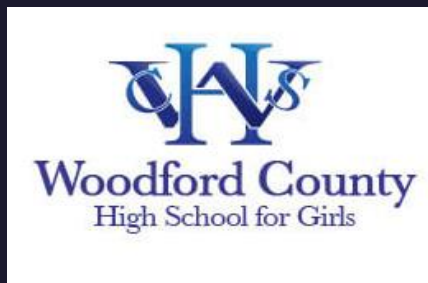
Your first day will be Thursday 3rd September.

But first, you will meet your Form Tutor, see your Form Room and be given your timetable!



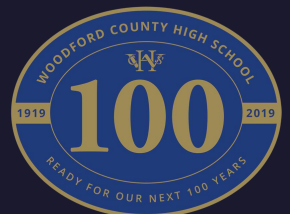
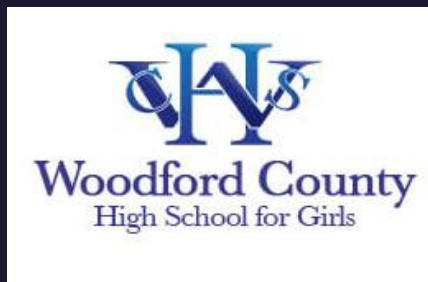
Feeling Nervous?

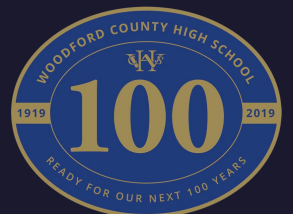
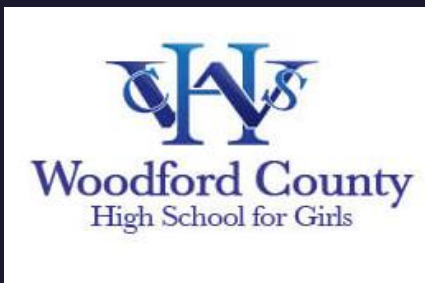
- You will be sent information about who your Form Tutor is and they will be one of the first people you meet in September!

You will see in the booklet that we have 5 minutes between some lessons – this is to allow you to move around the school site.

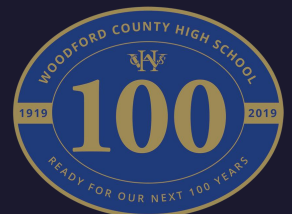
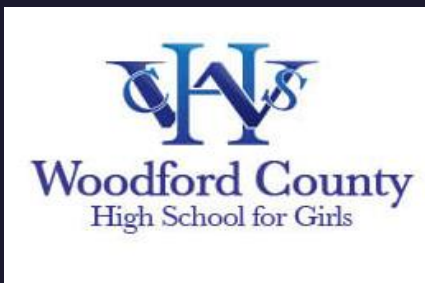

School Bag!

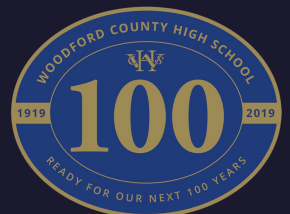
Each and every student will have a personal locker in school. This is where you can keep your packed lunch, phone, personal items, PE kit etc. so you don't have to carry it around all day.

Lanyard and Fob

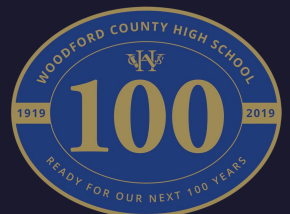
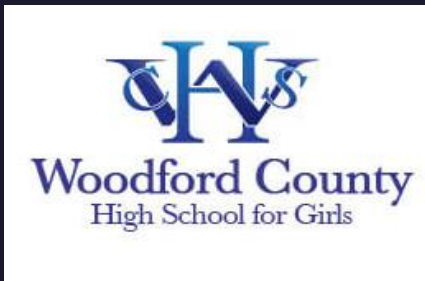
Each student will be issued with a Fob and Locker key on your first day. The fob allows you to access the external doors of the school.

(Lanyard is £2 - this can be paid on Parent Pay) (Fob and locker key deposit - £10 via Parent Pay)



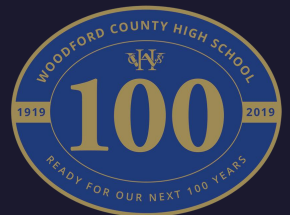
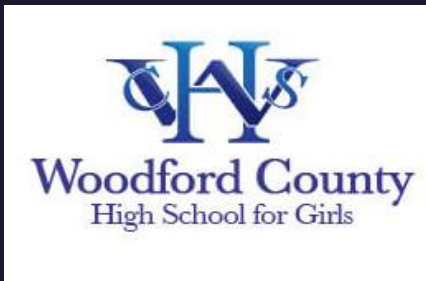
School Uniform

You can have a SHORT or LONG sleeve school shirt – that is up to you. However, you will need a long sleeve shirt for our special birthday celebrations...

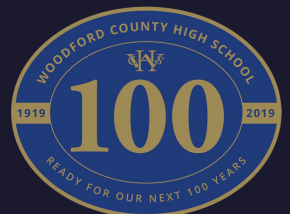
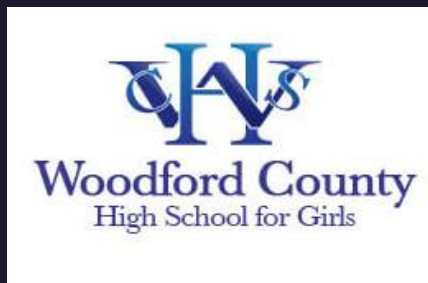


School Birthday

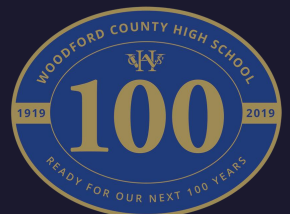
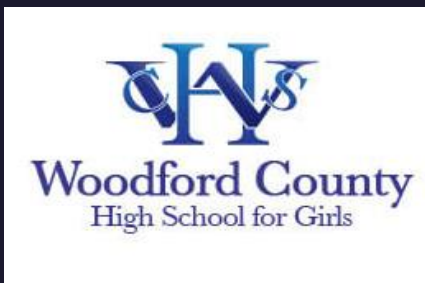

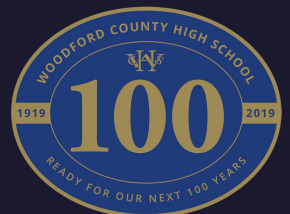
PE at WCHS

During your time at Woodford you will have 2 x PE lessons a week. The activities we had planned to deliver to the Y7 cohort of 2020 for the upcoming academic year were; Netball; Gymnastics; Football; Volleyball; Badminton; Dance; Tag Rugby; Fitness; Rounders; Athletics; Cricket and Basketball. This may have to change in the current climate but we will still aim to provide a broad range of activities for pupils to participate in where possible.

You will need to bring your full PE kit to each lesson as there will be times when you have to go outside even if it is wet. If you are unable to participate in a PE for any reason you must still bring your kit and get changed for the lesson so you can assist the teacher as a coach; umpire or scorer.

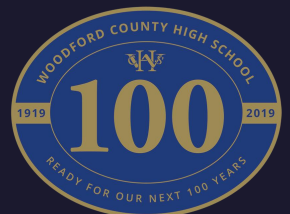
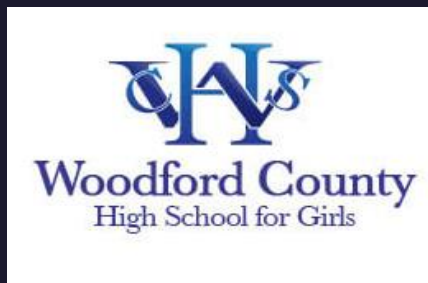
The peer support team will host an assembly at the start of term to introduce themselves, explain their aims and give meeting information!

Please do remember, you are ALL in the same position.



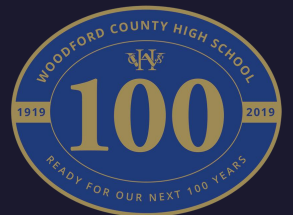
Your thoughts...

Keep this safe and look at it again on your last day of year 7! You will be amazed how much will change in your first year!



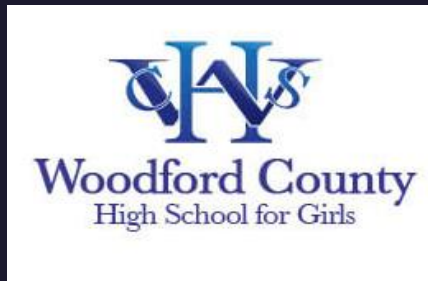
Our thoughts...
