Availability of Home Test Kits

The high transmissibility of the Delta virus variant means that, to limit numbers isolating, it is more important than ever to identify cases early, before the infected individual is in school potentially passing the virus on to others.

We therefore seek your assistance and encourage all students to continue twice weekly testing during the remainder of this school term. As numbers of cases are on the rise both locally and nationally and it is important that we continue to do as much as possible to keep each other safe.

The school continues to receive supplies of Rapid Flow Test kits (LFT) for distribution to Staff and Students. Your form Tutor will regularly ask Students if additional kits are required. Students should confirm if they need more test kits. These will be delivered to their form room for collection.

We would also ask that you continue to report your test results whether negative, positive or Void to both the NHS via the NHS website https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result

In addition, please report the result to the school via our Microsoft form Students Covid Results - Home test reporting

Use of testing kits for those with COVID Symptoms

Lateral Flow Test Kits should only be used by those who are asymptomatic. If you have COVID Symptoms and take a Lateral Flow Test (LFT), the school will not allow you to return to school, even if the result of the LFT is negative.

If you have any of the recognised COVID symptoms, (new cough, high temperature, loss of smell and or taste), you **MUST** take a **PCR** test and continue to isolate at home whilst you await the result. Should a PCR test produce a negative result, you will be able to return to school immediately.

Some parents are still sending students to school who are symptomatic but have not had a PCR test. If that occurs, these girls WILL be sent home.

Onsite Lateral Flow Testing September 2021

Last week, the department for Education advised that secondary schools should undertake onsite Lateral Flow Testing (ATS) for all students at or just before the start of the Autumn Term. We are currently planning for this event with the aim of inviting all students to attend the school at a specific time between Tuesday 31st August and Thursday 2nd September to undertake a Lateral Flow Test.

Whilst taking the test is voluntary, we aim to achieve high level of student's participation to ensure the effectiveness of the testing regime. (In March 2021 we tested 90% of students and we would very much like to achieve similar levels of uptake in the Autumn Term)

Consent to undertake onsite Lateral Flow Testing

The school needs consent from parents / students to conduct onsite testing. Those parents who signed consent forms for their daughters for the March 2021 onsite testing need not provide consent for the upcoming onsite testing as your initial consent covers you for any future onsite testing.

If you or your daughter did not give consent to undertake onsite testing and would like to do so, please complete the Microsoft form by following the link below.

To facilitate the planning for the above, and to respond to any further Government guidance, the school will be sending regular messages to parents and students during the summer holidays via groupcall. Please look out for these messages as they will contain important information.

ORDERING CANTEEN FOOD – MENU – WEEK 2

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PRE - ORDERING OF SCHOOL

A reminder the process:

- 2 Meals must be pre-ordered the week before using the link provided.
- 2 There is an electronic menu that students will need to complete by a specified time each week.
- ② Students must complete their choices for the whole week or for their chosen days. They will be asked to enter their name and form and their daily selection.
- ② If a student chooses not to take a canteen lunch on any of the five days (for example, they choose to buy food from the canteen Monday to Thursday but not Friday), then they must bring a packed lunch from home on the Friday. The canteen will only prepare meals based on the pre order forms submitted.
- ② No payments will be accepted in the canteen. Harrisons will charge student accounts daily based on their preorder form. It is important that you have sufficient funds on your ParentPay account for these charges to be made.
- ② Should a student be absent on the day a meal has been ordered, you can cancel the meal by emailing

<u>enquiries@woodford.redbridge.sch.uk</u> by 8am on the day of absence and you will not be charged for any food that day.

If a student is to be absent for more than 1 day, please provide this information in your email and all food choices will be cancelled and no charge made.

Food can be ordered by selecting the link below – this will open up the form, selecting the dishes you would like for each day of the week .

You should enter your First name, Surname, Form and your menu choices for each day you require a canteen lunch.

You should then click on the Submit button at the end of the form. Please take care with your selection and ensure that you have ticked all the relevant options before you submit the form.

The cut off point for ordering remains 9pm Sunday evening.

SAFER SCHOOLS & YOUTH ENGAGEMENT NEWSLETTER

Welcome to the second Safer Schools and Youth Engagement Newsletter! We hope you have a happy and safe Summer Holiday! Please remind your child when out to be vigilant of their surroundings and to be conscious of their personal safety such as not having personal possessions on display.



HARD CALLS SAVE LIVES

Knife crime is a topic that strikes fear in the hearts of every parent and is something that our schools team are highly focused on.

The Safer schools Teams have delivered numerous weapons workshops to young people from year 6 to year 11. We often hear during these sessions that the reason that they or their mate may carry a weapon is for their own protection. Carrying a weapon does not make them safer, it makes them more vulnerable. Many children also tell us that even if they knew someone was carrying a knife they wouldn't tell anyone due to the fear of the consequences for telling but also because they have a misconception that everyone does it and it's almost now acceptable.

Our team have carried out numerous knife arch operations at schools and colleges as well as public places. Thankfully it is very rare that weapons are found during these operations. These knife arches are then followed up with weapon sweeps in the vicinity to check for any discarded weapons and again very rarely are they found — any that are get seized and destroyed. You may have heard about the charity **Crimestoppers** which is a **completely anonymous platform** for you to provide information that could ultimately save the life of your child or someone else's child. fearless

Did you know that Crimestoppers also have a platform specifically aimed at young people called Fearless? The Fearless platform gives your child a safe place to give information about crime, and is 100% anonymous and untraceable. This takes away the fear of reprisals for telling someone, and gives the power back to your child to do the right thing. Fearless is accessible via link: www.fearless.org

VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN & GIRLS — police in Havering, Redbridge and Barking & Dagenham have been working closely with local authorities and other partner agencies to develop and implement proactive work in order to reduce violence against women and girls. Examples of this work have included our licencing team working with venues as part of the "Ask for Angela" campaign and our Safer Transport Teams patrolling school bus routes. Our schools team have been delivering presentations around "consent", and increasing awareness and encouraging reporting of sexual offences and harassment. What is Discord?

Discord is a chat room app commonly used by gamers, it is used to talk to other players while playing games. Users can send direct messages swap tips and advice with other players in game-specific servers (similar to online forums). Some games, like Fortnite and PUBG, have official verified Discords for fans to talk about the game.

Most significantly, you do not have to download an app to use it as it can be accessed via any browser and is free to use.

This is being shared with you to make you aware that the Discord social networking tool is geared towards adults, not children and young people.

LBR Holiday Activities and Food Programme (HAF) – Summer and Winter 2021

The London Borough of Redbridge, in partnership with third party organisations (to be confirmed), are offering a holiday activity and food programme to children who are eligible for Free School Meals in the Summer and Winter holidays 2021.

Sessions will include:

Daily physical activity

Enriching activities

Nutritional education

Sessions will take place at 10 school locations across Redbridge for four hours per day, four days a week for four weeks in Summer Holidays 2021 and a further one week in the Winter Holidays 2021. Primary school children and secondary school children will attend different locations and only one location can be allocated per child.

The holiday programme aims to help children to learn new skills and try a variety of enriching and fun activities. Sessions will run between 10:00 and 14:00 on the following days:

- Summer Week 1 26/07/21; 27/07/21; 28/07/21; and 29/07/21.
- Summer Week 2 02/08/21; 03/08/21; 04/08/21; and 05/08/21.
- Summer Week 3 09/08/21; 10/08/21; 11/08/21; and 12/08/21.
- Summer Week 4 16/08/21; 17/08/21; 18/08/21; and 19/08/21.
- Winter Week 1 20/12/21; 21/12/21; 22/12/21; and 23/12/21.

A lunchbreak will be included in this, where all participants will receive a free school meal, from a range of options.

Entry criteria:

- Eligible for, and in receipt of, Free School Meals (not including those accessing universal entitlement for Free School Meals unless they also meet the eligibility criteria for FSM)
- √ Age 5-16 years

If you would like your child to take part, please register your interest no later than 5.00pm on Friday 9 July 2021 at https://forms.office.com/r/ySsTTseaN5.

Once we have confirmed your child is eligible and a place is available, we will confirm the details with you and share you and your child's information with the third-party organisation that will be responsible for offering the activities to your child. Please note that, if your child is under 8 years of age, we may require you to attend all sessions with them.





Privacy notice – Children and young people attending the Holiday Activities and Food Programmes 2021

Who we are and what we do

The London Borough of Redbridge is known as the 'Controller' of the personal data you provide to us under the current UK Data Protection Legislation. The information you provide when registering for the Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme Summer and Winter Holidays 2021 will be shared between, and stored by, the London Borough of Redbridge and the commissioned activity provider at your child's HAF provision to enable management of the HAF Programme Summer and Winter Holidays 2021

Why we need your information and how we use it

The Department for Education has provided funding to the London Borough of Redbridge to provide children eligible for free school meals with the opportunity to access enriching learning opportunities and healthy and nutritious food during the holidays. Your personal data on the HAF Summer and Winter Holidays 2021 request form will be used by the local authority and the partner organisation that will be providing HAF provision to your child or children, to manage applications for HAF Summer and Winter Holidays 2021 places. Both parties will hold this data securely and in line with data protection legislation.

What type of information is collected from you

This data includes your contact details, your child's details, their medical information, details of any additional needs and characteristic such as ethnic group.

Who your information may be shared with

By sharing some personal and sensitive information it enables us to provide the Holiday Activities and Food Programme Summer and Winter Holidays 2021 to your child and ensure that they are kept safe. You and your child's details will be shared by the London Borough of Redbridge to the partner organisation which is providing the HAF activities to your child or children in full. Any information on the HAF Programme Summer and Winter Holidays 2021 shared with any other third parties, such as the Department for Education, is anonymised and reported in an aggregated form.

How long we keep your information

The local authority is subject to the same legal constraints under the current UK Data Protection Legislation in how it deals with data. The information will be held securely and destroyed by 31 March 2022, or upon completion of the HAF Programme Summer and Winter Holidays 2021 reporting, whichever is soonest. This data will only be used for the above purpose and will not be shared unless for specific purposes allowed by law.

Your information: choice and rights

Children, as data subjects, have certain rights under the current UK Data Protection Legislation, including a general right to be given access to personal data held about them by any controller. Anyone with parental responsibilities can make a request on behalf of a child until the child is at an age of understanding, usually around the age of 12. The Information Commissioner is the UK's independent body set up to uphold information rights. 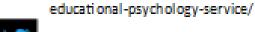
