Parents of girls in Y5 who are interested in applying to Woodford County High School for entry to Y7 in September 2023 are warmly invited to attend our Live Admissions Information Event. This event will be online and accessible via the school website www.woodford.redbridge.sch.uk at 6:30pm on Thursday 12th May. You do not need to register beforehand. The briefing is aimed primarily at parents but, of course, children may also view it alongside their parents. There will be a chance to ask questions. The entry test will be on Saturday 17th September 2022.

An on-site *Open Evening* event is planned for Mid-October 2022 after test results have been published and before the deadline for Secondary School Applications. The Parents / Carers of applicants who've met the pass mark in the test will be able to book to visit the school to support informed decision making about secondary school preferences. See our website, in October, for details. We look forward to meeting you then.

Please note that **all Y5 parents who wish to have the option** of naming Woodford County High School as a preferred Secondary School must **register for the 11+ test** via the Redbridge website. Registration is now open and closes on **30th June 2022**.

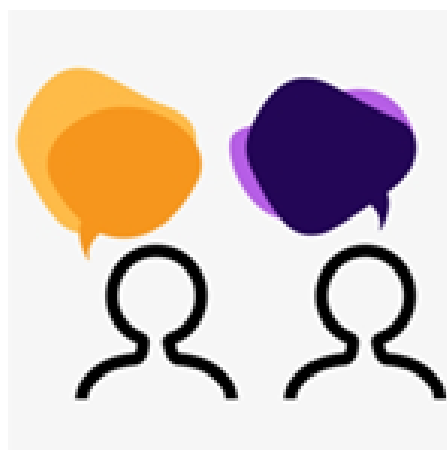


Educational Psychology Parent Helpline
