#### **Redbridge Equalities Awareness (REA)**

A commitment to promoting equality at Woodford has seen us launch a number of initiatives this past decade from whole school activities on the Equalities Duty to training Equalities Ambassadors, establishing an Equalities Forum and encouraging student participation in a wide range of activities and campaigns. Equalities training is part of our annual professional development programme for all staff, focusing most recently on the significance of language choices and on diversifying the curriculum. Our annual equalities objectives are available for reference in the Equalities Duty section of the website. While we have ourselves sought over the years to evaluate the impact of such initiatives, we recognise a need more formally to gather feedback from the Woodford community.

To that end in January this year WCHS joined the Redbridge Equalities Awareness Scheme (REA) — a local initiative working with LBR schools to promote racial equality and to increase the confidence of staff, parents and young people to discuss race and equality.


A central component of the Redbridge Equalities Awareness (REA) Scheme is a questionnaire inviting the views of students, parents and school staff. REA want to hear about the experiences of everyone in the school community and would value ideas about what could be done differently. 



# Are you looking after a child who is not your own?

- Is the child under 16 (or 18 if they have a disability)?
- Are you NOT the child's step parent, sibling, aunt, uncle or grandparent? This also includes host families to overseas students
- Do you plan to have the child with you for more than 28 days?
- This is called "private fostering" and we must be LEGALLY notified to ensure the child is safe.


