- In fact these professions are open to any graduate: 5% of Engineering and History students typically take up these jobs on graduation.
- "I must do a degree (and therefore A Levels) linked to a vocation to be sure of getting a
  job."
- In fact fewer than 5% of jobs in the commercial and business sector require specific degrees.
