A Schedule is on display in the Music Department.


Participating students will be dismissed as normal at 3.30pm but should return to school by 6.30pm.





LBR New campaign to help feed children at Easter – can you help?

- 1) The London Borough of Redbridge (LBR) have launched a fundraising campaign with local charity, Tin in a Bin, to be able to provide food vouchers for families struggling with the cost of living during the Easter holidays. This will be for children who are not eligible for free school meals but need some extra help. Those who are eligible for FSM will receive vouchers as this is funded through the Household Support Fund. They are hoping to raise enough funds to support 200 children across the borough.

Millions of families are facing not knowing where the next meal is coming from, so the Community Grocery is here to help. Step inside a grocery (opening on 28 March in Ilford) and you'll find a range of food options fresh from local supermarkets, meaning you can shop for the whole family at the fraction of the cost of a supermarket. Residents who are struggling financially can join the scheme by paying £5 per year and they can go and get groceries (mini shop) for maximum of £4 at a time.
