Dear Parents / Carers,

Further NEU Strike Action announced

You will be aware that the pay offer publicised in March has been rejected by teaching union members. We have been informed by the National Education Union (NEU) that they will be taking further industrial action in the form of a strike on two days in the next fortnight: **Thursday 27 April** and **Tuesday 2 May**. This action is not against the School itself but is part of national industrial action organised by this trade union about teachers' pay and its funding. We have not been informed by the union of which members of staff will take action, but believe that a significant proportion of teachers at Woodford will be involved (as was the case on strike days last term).

We are looking at the viability of opening the school to the examination year groups (Y11 & Y13) on these days and will communicate further at the beginning of next week. We anticipate, however, that students in all other year groups (KS3, Y10 and Y12) will be required to study from home via WCHS Remote Schooling on these days.

The Y10 Parents' Evening on Thursday 27 April has consequently been rescheduled to Thursday 4 May 2023.

I write to you now to give you maximum notice of likely school closures on the two strike days cited above. Formal notification will follow next week.


- Cupcakes or cookies should be taken to the dining room between 8:00am and 8:20am on Friday


