Coronation Celebration at Woodford on Friday

At Woodford we seek to contribute to and to mark the history being made around us and to furnish all our students with a memory of notable events. Hence we celebrated (among other things) the London Olympics in 2012, the Tour de France Peloton whizzing past our gates in 2014, our own school centenary in 2019 and the Queen's Platinum Jubilee last year. On Saturday King Charles III will be crowned in Westminster Abbey – and everyone, we hope, will enjoy the associated additional Bank Holiday on Monday 8 May 2023.

We will mark the occasion in school on Friday this week with a lunch time street / garden party, an associated activity we think our students will enjoy (still under wraps!) and a couple of prize-worthy challenges which you have seen us advertising for some weeks now.

- 1. A dress-up challenge: in place of uniform students are party like royalty for the day dressing as: "Kings and Queens historical, fictional or fantastical". Please encourage your child to take part. It's certainly not too late. We know neither families nor staff have costume boxes at home the competition brief is deliberately broad and designed to be test of creativity and lateral thinking, not of sartorial resources!
- 2. A baking challenge: Coronation Cupcakes or Cookies

We hope we'll have a colourful and enjoyable day and that those all-important memories will be made. There are no additional costs associated with the day but it would be in the interest of students to have just a modest amount of cash with them at lunchtime on Friday. (We'll remind them in school too.)

On the day


- Cupcakes or cookies should be taken to the dining room between 8:00am and 8:20am on Friday










Year 11 & 13 RETURN Your Library Books
