### **BEWARE CYBER-ATTACKS**

As you may be aware, there has been an increase in cyber-attacks in the local area in the past few weeks. To stay safe online, please be cautious of suspicious emails and attachments:

**Do NOT click on any links or open email attachments in unsolicited or suspicious emails.** Attackers often use phishing techniques to trick unsuspecting victims into compromising their systems. If you receive an email that appears suspicious or contains unexpected attachments, it is best to refrain from interacting with it and promptly delete it.


Use a strong, unique password (consider using a passphrase or "three random words") & Do NOT use passwords that you also use for other systems. # Are you looking after a child who is not your own?

- Is the child under 16 (or 18 if they have a disability)?
- Are you NOT the child's step parent, sibling, aunt, uncle or grandparent? This also includes host families to overseas students
- Do you plan to have the child with you for more than 28 days?
- This is called "private fostering" and we must be LEGALLY notified to ensure the child is safe.
