Dear Parents / Carers,

Further NEU Strike Action announced — Wednesday 5 and Friday 7 July

You will be aware that the pay offer publicised in March has been rejected by teaching union members. The National Education Union (NEU) announced at the weekend that they will be taking further industrial action in the form of a strike nationally on two days at the beginning of July: Wednesday 5 and Friday 7 July 2023. This action is not against the School itself but is part of national industrial action organised by this trade union about teachers' pay and its funding. We have not been informed by the union of which members of staff will take action, but believe that a significant proportion of teachers at Woodford will be involved (as has been the case on each strike day in the current dispute).

Decisions regarding the school's operation on the these two days will be made and communicated nearer the time. I write to you now to give you maximum notice of the likelihood of school closures on the two strike days cited above.

Our New Year 7 Introductory Day (and the evening meeting for our September Y7 entrants' parents) is scheduled for Thursday 6 July and thus will go ahead undisturbed.




