Dear Parents / Carers,

NEU Industrial Action: School closed to students Wednesday 5 July and Friday 7 July 2023

We have been informed by the National Education Union (NEU) that they will be taking industrial action in the form of a strike on two non-consecutive days next week (see above). You will already have noted these dates from last week's bulletin. This action is not against the School itself but is part of national industrial action organised by this trade union about teachers' pay and its funding. We have not been informed by the union of which members of staff will take action, but believe that a significant proportion of teachers at Woodford will be involved (as has been the case on every strike day throughout the current period of Action.)

Neither the governing body nor the Head are legally allowed to close the School 'in sympathy' with the strike and we will not do so. However, we are responsible for the safety of our students. A risk assessment has been completed. Supervision levels on the days of the strike cannot be guaranteed to be adequate to ensure the safety of our students on site and for this reason Woodford will be closed to all students on Wednesday 5 and Friday 7 July 2023. Those teachers who are working on these days will be teaching lessons via MS Teams for their timetabled lessons. The incidence of lessons taught is not predictable at this point. Students should check communications on Satchel One first thing and throughout the day and should log into MS Teams for the first 5 minutes of each lesson slot, to determine if a live lesson is occurring. They are otherwise advised to use the time to catch up on any outstanding work, to review or revise recent learning and to read for pleasure. Students need to take home any necessary resources on the previous day, in either case.

For attendance purposes the absence of students will recorded as "exceptional circumstances" and therefore your child's attendance record will not be affected. Students entitled to free school meals will have access to their Wednesday and Friday meal allowance all next week.

I write to you now to give you notice of this issue. I regret having to close the school but consider there to be no safe alternative. School will operate as normal on Thursday 6 July and our New Year 7 Introductory events will continue as planned. Next week's MFL Visit to Germany is not impacted by this industrial action.




