


We still have a large number of unclaimed items of lost property box in reception.

"Chef Dom" as we know him, visited our KS4 classes and Year 9's during the autumn term for Black History Month to share his culinary skills with our students and experience working in the food industry in a Q & A session.

At the time of his visit Chef Dom told Ms Rhodes and I that he had something in the pipeline. Little did we know that he was involved in a new TV competition judged by the culinary legend and Langham chef Michel Roux Jr, leading global restaurateur, Mike Reid and pastry master and hospitality consultant Ravneet Gill.

After six episodes of gruelling challenges in the elite world of five – star dining, Chef Dom was crowned the winner, beating twelve contestants in the episode aired on Channel 4 on Friday 14th July 2023. His prize is to open a restaurant at The Langham's Palm Court initially for six months.
