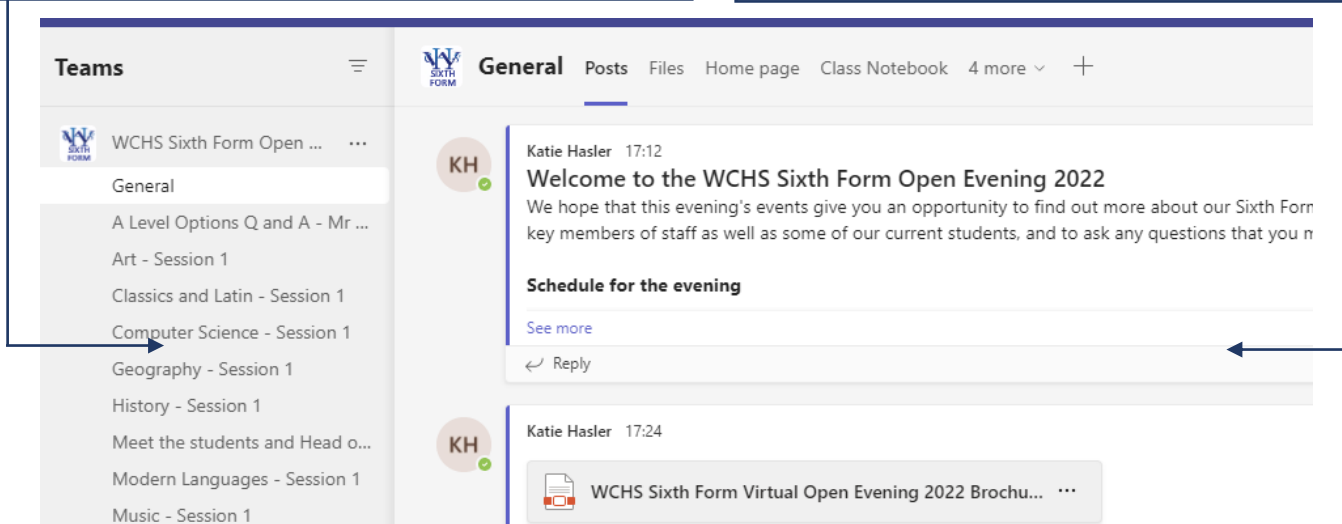
HOW TO ACCESS OUR LIVE EVENT USING TEAMS

Prior to the live event on 17th October, you will be added to a Microsoft Team using the email address that you provided to us (for current Woodford students, you should use your school email address). To access this Team, please sign into Microsoft Teams— in your browser at teams.microsoft.com or by downloading the Microsoft Teams app (we recommend that you do this in advance if you have not used Teams before).

Within Teams, you will have access to the 'WCHS Sixth Form Virtual Open Evening' Team, which can be navigated as shown below.

Channels appear on the left—the 'General' channel will host the Introductory Talk, after which you can access the Q&A sessions via the separate subject channels.

Content appears on the right—this is where you will see messages in each channel as well as 'join' buttons for the introductory talk and subject Q&A sessions.
